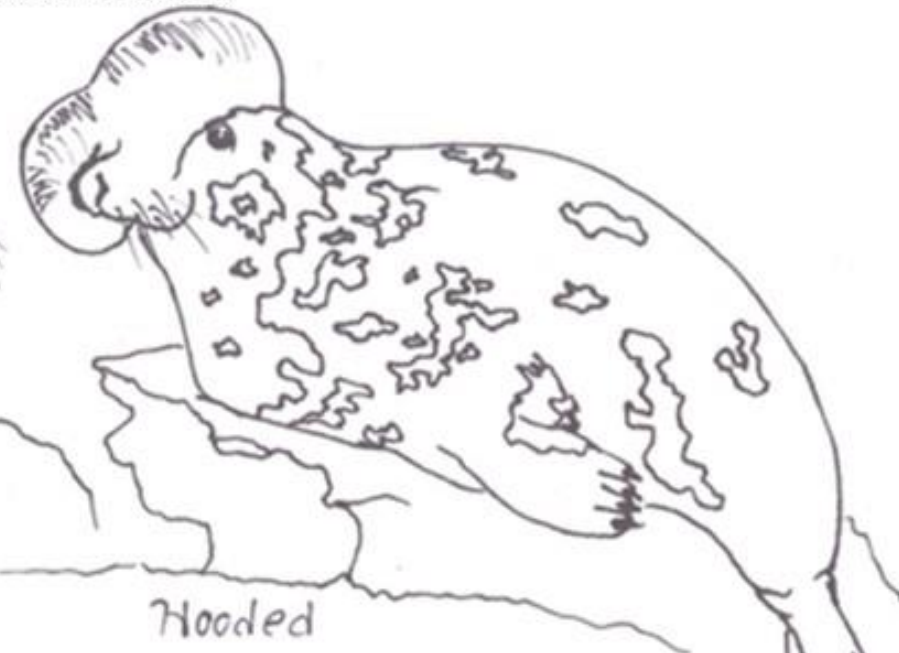




# NATIONAL MARINE L I F E C E N T E R
